

NEW CPR method

CPR stands for Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation. This is an emergency procedure for people suffering cardiac arrest or respiratory arrests. CPR creates artificial circulation of blood through rhythmic pressing of the patient's chest to manually pump blood through the heart and keep the patient alive until the medical emergency team arrives. The procedure also involves artificial respiration through breathing through the patient's mouth. But the artificial respiration is down played by some doctors. Mayo clinic has come out with a new CPR procedure.
